

2016 03 Agreement between VU and 3 co-founders of the Fund.

2016 04 Vilnius University Foundation is being registered.

2017 05 Endowment capital of **1 M euros** is being formed.

2018 10 **Board of Investments** and **CEO** position set up.

2019 01 Begins Investments into various asset classes.

2019 06 Online crowdfunding for endowment launches.

2020 03 Finance Vilnius University from first investment returns.

2020 05 Endowment capital size reaches 2 M euros.

2020 09 Investment returns reaches **77 K euros**.



Our Investment Strategy

Investment philosophy



Aim for long-term endowment value appreciation while investing into well-diversified financial assets.



Max. investment into one asset – 20% of the endowment capital value.



Infinite lifetime > long-term investment strategy > ability to potentially take stock market risk and less liquid investable assets.



Base currency – Euro; however, other currencies can be considered.

Max. investment value based on other currencies is 50%.



Efficient asset management, aiming for maximum optimization of management, transaction, custody and



To invest both in local and global market. Investments in foreign markets to be focused on developed markets with strong economies, low political risk and high standards of corporate governance.



Strategy of Allocating Investment Returns

6 priorities in financing Vilnius University




Amount and philosophy of VU support, project financing criteria

- Goal: stable and increasing support.
- Spending rate: ensuring the preservation of endowment capital value; growing rate as endowment capital increases.
- Spending rate formula (% of endowment capital value): taking into account previous year's donation sum and current value.
- Reserves: in case of lack of recent investment returns, reserves will be used to guarantee stable support level to VU.
- The initiatives that will be financed by the Fund will be selected by a special committee and sponsors.


